<b><i>Lt. Col. William R. Holmes</i></b>	Co. D, 2nd. Regt. Ga. Vol. Infantry ANV (Burke Sharpshooters)	B. 1821 D. Sept. 17. 1862	Son of Joseph B. Holmes and Jane B. Blount. He was Captain of the Burke Sharpshooters and promoted to Lt. Col. on April 28, 1862. Lt. Col. Holmes was killed at Sharpsburg, Maryland on Sept. 17, 1862 while defending a bridge against tremendous Union odds. There is a possibility that he is buried in the Neyland Section of the Waynesboro Confederate Cemetery. Memorial Marker placed at Waynesboro Confederate Cemetery.
<b><i>George Foster Pierce Lawson</i></b>	Co C, 5th. Georgia Cavalry	B. 1838 D. 1862	He died in an army hospital. This Confederate marker replaces a worn marker in the Lawson Section of the Waynesboro Confederate Cemetery.
<b><i>Pvt. John O'Banion</i></b>	Co. D, 48th Regt. Ga. Infantry ANY (Burke Volunteers)	B. 1831 D. 1863	Pvt. O'Banion was married to Martha (Patsy) Lively O'Banion. He was killed at Gettysburg on July 2, 1863 at the age of 32. There is no record of his burial in Burke County. His wife is buried in the Lively-Holland Cemetery near Girard, Ga. Memorial Marker placed at Waynesboro Confederate Cemetery.
<b><i>Capt. Walter A. Thompson</i></b>	Co. D, 2nd. Regt. Ga. Infantry ANY (Burke Volunteers)		Captain Thompson was a 2nd Lt. on April 19, 1861, and elected Captain April 28, 1862. He was killed at Malven Hill, Va. on July 1, 1862. This marker replaces a worn one located in the Waynesboro Confederate Memorial Cemetery.

Williams was killed at Gettysburg, Pa. and is buried with the Union soldiers in the Pennsylvania Plot at the Gettysburg National Cemetery. This is a memorial marker to commemorate his service to the Confederacy and is placed here at the Waynesboro Confederate Cemetery in his honor.
